Subject: Course Structure revision for 2016-18 Batch.

This is to bring to your kind notice that the syllabus for MBA and MBA (Service Management) 2016-18 was developed so as to be in conformity with the course structure of other Post Graduate Departments of the University. As a result, in the MBA programs 24 papers of 6 credits each were offered. Any student is required to obtain 120 credits (20 papers of 6 credits each) in order to obtain the degree. This makes the minimum number of papers to be cleared only 20.

However, the feedback on the syllabus from Faculty Staff Council, Industry, Alumni and students has been:

- 1. An MBA based on 24 papers is not in conformity with the number of papers specified for MBA by regulatory bodies such as UGC and AICTE. Both these bodies prescribe a minimum of 30 papers.
- 2. Any student wishing to pursue higher studies will not be eligible to do so at any other reputed university as 24 papers are not in conformity with the course structure of any reputed Indian University such as Delhi University, Mumbai University and Punc University. Even RTU prescribed course structure has minimum of 30 papers.
- 3. On account of limitation on number of papers being 20 to obtain 120 credits the student has a choice to not opt for all functional area papers. Therefore, a very ambiguous situation has arisen where students doing MBA from UOR is not studying all the functional area papers and still get an MBA degree that affects his or her employability.
- 4. As per the course structure, the student is not studying the sufficient number of papers so as to be effectively prepared to take the UGC-NET/ UPSC / Any other competitive examination.

In view of the above mentioned reasons, the revision of course structure is highly recommended in the best interest of the University and the students. Therefore, the course structure for 2016-18 batch needs revision so as to increase the number of papers from 24 to 30. These changes are proposed to be implemented immediately for Semester II 2016-18 Batch. May I request you to take up the revision of 2016-18 course structure and 2017-19 course structure as a table item for the Academic Council meeting scheduled on 16/01/2017.
